COURSE DESCRIPTION AND SUPPLIES NEEDED

In this class we will explore the various ways of creating a hollow bead using flame working techniques. We will explore end-of-the-mandrel vessels and the use of the Puffy Mandrel to increase the size of the bead.

Ways of making and working with stringer will also be part of this workshop.

Understanding the regions of the flame and their influence on stringer control will help students perfect stringer techniques.

This class is aimed at those whose skills are beyond beginning bead making.

Student supplies:

- Your personal lampworking tools
- Protective filtering glasses – supplied in Melbourne, Sydney and Adelaide
- Effetre glass - we recommend at least 10 1/3 cut rods, 2 rods per bead
- One rod black Filagrano
- 10 x 3/32" (2.31 mm) bead mandrels, please bring your own mandrels ready to go (mark them if you can)
- Bead release
